President's Message





SMCC Field Trips for August 2023 and Beyond by Penni Powell

August 19th (Sat 4-6pm+) - Waller Park Animal Safari in Santa Maria (A dog friendly field trip)

"Animals" is the competition theme for September so let us find some at Waller Park (3107 Orcutt Rd, Santa Maria). At 4pm meet at the Pony Ride Arena in the park. The pony rides can be reached by taking the Orcutt Expressway and turning onto West Waller Lane, then turning left onto Orcutt Road. Turn right at the first road into the park and go about two-tenths of a mile to the arena. **Animal = Ponies** Next, we will find the W.O.O.F. Pac dog park which is on the Westside of the park adjacent to the Hagerman Softball Complex. There are two fenced off areas, one for small dogs and the other for larger canines. **Animal = Dogs** Lastly, we will head for the duck ponds. Did you know that Waller Park is a bird watching hotspot? 180 bird species have been observed here with Mallard ducks being the most numerous. Maybe we will photograph the exotic Muscovy duck! Caution: There is duck poop so watch where you step... **Animal = Ducks and Geese** When we have exhausted our opportunities for photographs, it is optional to have dinner at a nearby eatery.
