- 1. Attendees: Jeanne Sparks, Richard Russ, Ramona Cashmore, Jim Ogg, Sharon Salerno, Alan Upshaw, Bill Hood, Tom Wahweotten and Rosie Brancacio. Nyla James and Bob Ginn arrived at 7:13 p.m. and Cheryl Decker arrived at 7:17 p.m. We have a quorum.
- 2. Board Members not in attendance: Flavio Parigi.
- 3. Approval of Minutes The Board read the 'draft' minutes from the meeting held on September 26, 2018. Changes to the minutes none. Richard motioned to approve the minutes, Alan seconded the motion, and the minutes were approved by the Board.

    - vii. Need someone for decorations
    - viii. Jeanne will get the awards for the event
